Federal Data Reporting

Why do we report?

The law requires states to increase performance levels annually.

Requirement

- Performance on Accountability Indicator data
- Program Improvement Plans (PIP)

Local Data Team

Data Team Roles

- a. Who on your team has access to WISEdata Portal?

Data Systems and Local Responsibilities

- **WISEdash for District**
- **Data Entry personnel that work with Student Information System**
- **Review of information before Snapshot, December 6, 2022**
 - Tip: Last chance to clear data errors December 2, 2022
- **CTE Coordinator who leads programs and review of data submitted, with a team.**

CTEC Data Responsibilities

- Work with Data Team to review:
 - Data Privacy training
 - Read the CTE/Career Education data before approving it! (Data is passive consent)
 - Roster Work Plan (row 2)
 - CTE Participant in WISEdash for District
 - CTE Concentrator in WISEdash for District
 - Certified/Non Certified in WISEdash for District
 - This work needs to be completed with a CTE Data Team. CTEC's can request access to WISEdash for District from District Administrators.
 - ALL CTE/Career Education Data is collect on December 6, 2022.
 - **Data review should be completed in WISEdash for District and correct by Thanksgiving for the data to sync and flow to DPI in time for the December Snapshot.**
 - **DPI uses certified Snapshot data for Perkins reporting.**
