3S1 - Post-Program Placement

- Post-Program Placement 3S1, Perkins V accountability indicator.
- CTE Concentrator Graduate Follow-Up Report serves to collect the data to meet WI Perkins V state plan.
- This data is submitted to the U.S. Department of Education in the Consolidated Annual Report, as required by Perkins V.
- WI Perkins V state plan increases the participation of respondents by .2% each year.





- School districts and consortia participating in Perkins V are required to follow-up and contact CTE Concentrator Graduates to obtain their status in post-secondary education and/or employment.
 - o follow-up is initiated in the second quarter after exiting from secondary education
- Data quality is very important for 3S1 Post-Program Placement. A minimum of 80% response rate is requested for data validity and sampling across the state.
 - lack of responses can create an unreliable state sample
 - this data provides school districts with outcome results that should drive CTE curriculum decisions
 - provides feedback about career readiness at the local level
 - pay attention to low response rates from special population groups and how this could affect your
 Comprehensive Learning Needs Assessment
- Districts will access their certified list of CTE Graduates from WISEdash for District (demo on slide 9)

Definitions:

- A <u>CTE concentrator</u> is a secondary student in 11th or 12th grade, who has completed at least two CTE courses in a single career pathway throughout high school.
- A CTE concentrator graduate is a secondary student who is a CTE concentrator and graduated from high school with a regular high school diploma. CTE concentrator graduate follow-up is initiated in the second quarter after exiting from secondary education.




