Introduction

- **Annual Perkins data is due for the December Career Education and CTE Snapshot.**
(You have 5 months to finish and review school year data before the December Snapshot.)
- Data in WISEdash for District is considered live and you can view it as your district sends the data to DPI.
- You can have all of your Perkins and CTE data complete by June 30th of each year.
- Perkins data is submitted to U.S. Department of Education, immediately after the December Snapshot.
- Perkins Accountability Reports use Snapshot data and the same data sent to U.S. Department of Education.
- Create and participate on a Career Education data team to ensure this data is done correctly and in time for the December Snapshot.
- Perkins Accountability Reports should never be a surprise because you can see your current data.

Not able to view FAFSA data.	
Economic Indicator Analyst	The Economic Indicator Analyst can view all summary dashboards, drill into the student list/student profile, utilize student search to access student profile, view Homeless Status information, view Migrant Status Information, view the Economic Disadv Status filter, view the Econ Disadv Code and Econ Disadv Description on the Student Profile. Not able to view FAFSA data.	
Detail FAFSA Access	The Detail FAFSA role can view all summary dashboards, drill into the student list/student profile, utilize student search to access student profile. Able to view FAFSA data. Not able to view Homeless Status information, Migrant Status Information, or Economic Indicators (Economic Disadv Status filter or Econ Disadv Code and Description on the Student Profile).	
Economic FAFSA Access	The Economic FAFSA role can view all summary dashboards, drill into the student list/student profile, utilize student search to access student profile, view Homeless Status information, view Migrant Status Information, view the Economic Disadv Status filter, view the Econ Disadv Code and Econ Disadv Description on the Student Profile. View FAFSA data.	
Summary Analyst	The Summary Analyst role can view all summary dashboards. Not able to drill into the student list/student profile or utilize student search to access student profile. Not able to view the Homeless Status, Migrant Status, or Economic Disadv Status filter. Not able to view FAFSA data.	
Snapshot Prep Role	This role has access to the WISEdash Snapshot dashboards only. Such access allows users to work with any snapshot dashboard in reconciling data and further allows users to drill into each dashboard and see student detail data. This access also includes access to economic data both at the summary and detail levels.

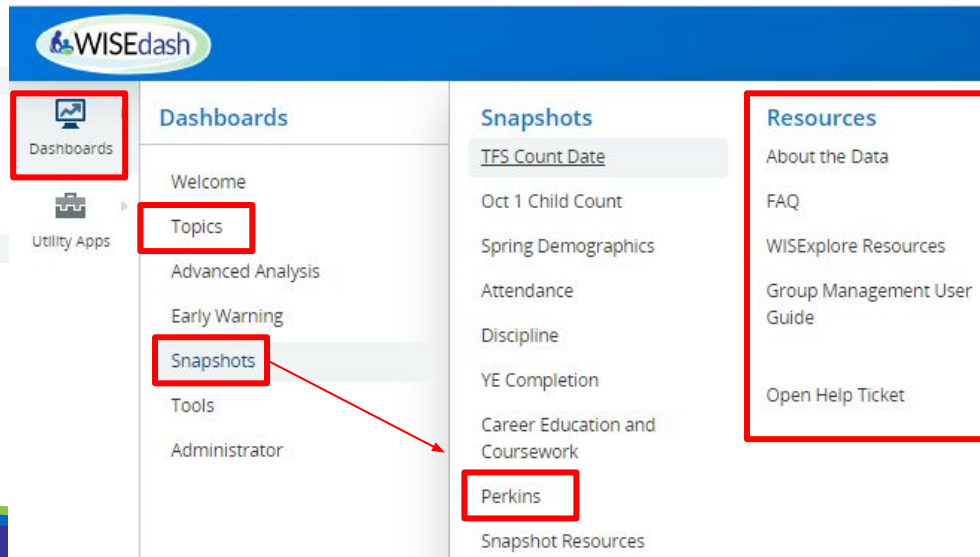

Cohort

- Create a Cohort of CTE Concentrators from Perkins Snapshot dashboard
- Navigate to Snapshot>Perkins dashboard
- Green chart is Current View for your current year data. This changes daily.
- Purple is Snapshot data from the last December Snapshot. This is certified data that was used in Perkins Accountability Reports.
- Scroll down to the Purple chart.

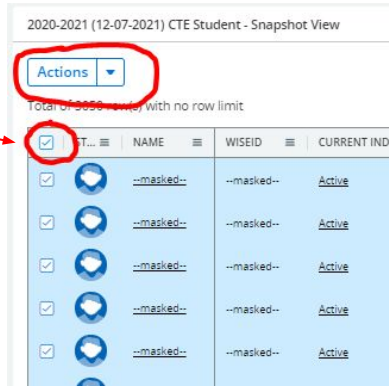

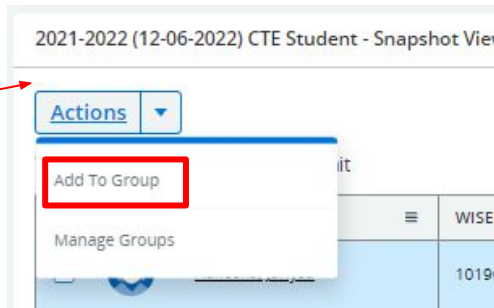

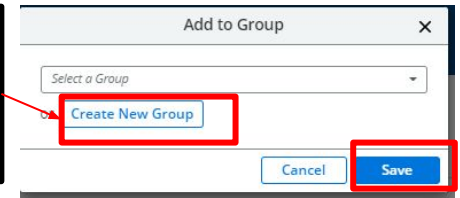
1. Click on the box to select all students.

Cohort

1. The cohort you created will show up under Filter Data.
2. Go to Student Cohort.
3. Your cohort will be available in all dashboards across WISEdash.
4. You may also use the pre-existing CTE Concentrator cohorts but keep track of the year in your head, to understand them.

Denominator - Number of CTE concentrators who form the adjusted four/seven-year cohort for the graduating class.

Performance Indicator Measure - CTE concentrator proficiency in the challenging State academic standards adopted by the State under ESEA, as measured by the academic assessments described in ESEA.

Numerator - Number of CTE senior concentrators who took the: ACT ELA/Math/Science Assessment in grade 11 and tested proficient and above

Denominator - Number of CTE senior concentrators who took the: ACT ELA/Math/Science Assessment in grade 11.

3S1 - Post Program Placement

Performance Indicator Measure - The percentage of CTE concentrators who, in the second quarter after exiting from secondary education, are in postsecondary education or advanced training, military service or a service program under the National and Community Service Act, are volunteers in the Peace Corps, or are employed

Numerator - Number of CTE concentrators who graduated in the previous school year with a positive outcome follow-up

Denominator - Number of CTE concentrators who graduated in the previous school year with a follow-up response

- Post Program Placement is not currently available in WISEdash for District.
- This data comes from the CTE Concentrator Graduate Survey that Districts collect.
- Fiscal Agents can review the internal collected data by:
 - Percentage of final positive responses (final positive are those students with contact that responded employed, college/university, or volunteer service)
 - Compare final positive responses against the number of students that did not respond.
 - Review final positive responses by Gender, Race, Special Populations.
 - Utilize [this spreadsheet](#) for further review. This is exactly what the U.S. Department of Education asks for.

3S1 - Post Program Placement

To view your CTE Graduates for the CTE Concentrator Graduate Survey:

1. Navigate to the Perkins Snapshot dashboard.
2. CTE Graduates will be from the last Snapshot that represents the year they graduated from High School. (Ex. 2022 CTE Graduates where in the 2021-2022 CTE Snapshot on December 6, 2022)
3. Click on the “Yes” to see student list.
4. On the new screen, navigate to the right and you have the option to download the student list.
5. Please be cautious before emailing this list. It contains [Sensitive Personal Identifying Information](#) that should not be emailed.

Denominator - Number of CTE concentrators in CTE program(s) that leads to a non-traditional field.

5S3 - WBL

Performance Indicator Measure - The percentage of CTE concentrators graduating from high school having participated in work-based learning.

Numerator - Number of CTE concentrators who graduated with a regular high school diploma in the academic year having participated in work-based learning at some time during high school.

Denominator - Number of CTE concentrators who graduated with a regular high school diploma in the academic year.

- Utilize the Perkins Snapshot dashboard to review WBL for CTE Concentrators.
- This dashboard uses a crosstab called Any WBL Program - it represents the same [WBL](#) categories as used on report cards.

5S3 - WBL

- If you want to see specific WBL learning program data, use the Career Education and Coursework Snapshot dashboard, Technical Skills Attainment Student Participation.
- Use the CTE Concentrator, Program Name, and Work Based Learning program crosstabs.
- This example also used the Certificated Program Status crosstab to see the outcomes of the Certified WBL opportunities. You may want to inquire and support those students that are continuing or left the program.
- The Career Education and Coursework dashboard is used for report cards.

- Student Participation Count - students counted once, no matter how many opportunities or hours per day scheduled.
- Outcome Count - students counted as many times as they are scheduled.

Reminders

- **All Perkins and CTE data is due for the December Career Education Snapshot.**
You have 5 months after the school year to complete the yearly data.
For example, school year 2022-2023 ends on June 1, 2023, the Career Education Snapshot is December 5, 2023.
- All Perkins and CTE data must be visible in WISEdash for District prior to a snapshot to confirm it appears the way you want it.
- This data is used for the Perkins - Consolidated Annual Report, immediately after the snapshot. DPI is required to complete the CAR by January 5.
- Career Education and CTE Snapshot data is considered certified data and will be used for Perkins Accountability Reports and report cards.
- Snapshot data will not be changed. Districts that believe they did not submit correct data should notify DPI through a [Data Errata](#) notice. Districts can update their data for their own purposes and view it in the Current chart. However, updated data after a Snapshot will not be used for state and federal reporting.
