Corrective Action: Calculate the total bad debt (students no longer enrolled) from unpaid meal charges accrued by students from July 1, 2018-June 30, 2023. Make a transfer from an Angel Fund and/or Fund 10 to Fund 50 to cover the bad debt from unpaid meal charges accrued from July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2023 and a copy of the general ledger documenting that a transfer was made to Fund 50 to cover the total bad debt.
