Foods provided but not sold (e.g., class parties, class snacks, rewards): A statement must be included such as, the district encourages foods offered on the school campus meet or exceed the USDA Smart Snacks in School nutrition standards including those provided at celebrations and parties and classroom snacks brought by staff or family members. Nonfood celebrations will be promoted and a list of ideas is available to staff and family members. 2. Triennial Assessment: A statement must be included such as, the district will evaluate compliance with the Wellness Policy no less than once every three years. The assessment will include the extent to which each school is in compliance with the policy and how the policy compares to a model policy, as established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Corrective Action: Submit a timeline for bringing the LWP into compliance and include the name(s) and title(s) of the SFA representative(s) that will ensure compliance.
