The following recipes lacked information that was specific to the Oak Creek-Franklin operations: Beefy Nachos & Damp; Sloppy Joes: both recipes did not have the option to use 85/15 ground beef, which was provided as the ground beef documentation for Oak Creek-Franklin. Beefy Nachos: The recipe states that there should only be 1.6 oz of tortilla chips provided, which would provide 1.5 oz eq grains but the crediting at the bottom states that this recipe provides 2.0 oz eq grains. Either the serving size or the crediting should be updated. Chef Salad: Hormel Ham and Turkey were not listed as options for the drop down deli meats. The 1 oz BRAND dinner roll was also not an option as the grain. This in turn, changed the crediting of this salad. Corrective Action: Submit updated standardized recipes for the Beefy Nachos, Sloppy Joes and the Chef Salad. Be sure to include all requirements of a standardized recipe that are site specific.
