However, OVS is required at the 9-12 grade level and pre-plating did not help with the efficiency of service. After the first of three lunch periods, the NPC and PHN discussed with the school nutrition professionals serving in the kitchen, way to speed service up and increase OVS. The second and third periods were much more efficient.
