As the menu planner, please ensure that each item listed has the proper serving size listed. Example: pound is not a garden bar serving size for diced tomatoes or sliced cucumber. Listing the number of larger garden bar items is also very helpful for staff and students. Example: Red bell pepper strips, how many strips equals an 1/8 or 1/4 cup.
