Civil rights legislation requires that in providing nonacademic services, including meals, school districts must ensure children with disabilities participate along with children without disabilities to the maximum extent appropriate. However, it may be appropriate for children with certain special needs to have a separate eating area or require assistance from an aide to choose and consume their meals. SFAs should determine, with input from the child's family, physician, and administration if this type of aid is helpful for the child. SFAs may not segregate children from the regular meal service due to their disability as a matter of convenience. If the student is eating in a separate area or unable to go through the lunch line and choose their own components, all components must be given to the adult picking up their meal. The child can then choose what they would like to eat. Leftover food cannot be consumed by adults (SP 26-2017, USDA, 04/25/17).

Be specific on production records about the identity, brand, portion size, and description of items served. Instead of "fruit juice cup", list both orange juice and apple juice separately to clearly indicate what was served.

- 1. Several meal accommodations are being made using two different medical forms. Neither form clearly indicates the type of medical professional signing the form. In some instances, the foods to omit or substitute are also unclear. It is recommended the SFA use the <u>Special Dietary Needs Medical form</u> on the DPI School Nutrition Website, so the form is clear and consistent for staff and families.
- 2. It is recommended the SFA create a Special Dietary Needs Policy using the <u>Special Dietary Needs Policy template</u> found on the DPI School Nutrition webpage. This will help ensure that families, administration, school nutrition, and school healthcare are consistent, along with minimizing the chance of civil rights complaints.
