

Statement on Implementation of the ESSA Fiscal Transparency Requirement 4/12/2019

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires that local and state educational agencies report per-pupil expenditures by school and funding source, beginning with the 2017-2018 school year. Under its authority to implement ESSA, the U.S. Department of Education is permitting states to delay this requirement to the 2018-2019 school year. The Department of Public Instruction is exercising this option.

We have developed an application to collect per-pupil expenditures by school, split between federal and state/local funding sources, beginning with the 2018-2019 school year. School-level expenditures for 2018-2019 onward will be published and submitted to the U.S. Department of Education with the other information required by ESSA, after year-end fiscal data has been reported and audited.
