

Hudson School District Regular Board of Education Meeting February 11, 2019

Open Session

- 1. The regular meeting of the Hudson Board of Education was called to order by Board President Jamie Johnson at approximately 6:00 p.m. in the first-floor meeting room of the Administrative Service Center, 644 Brakke Drive, Hudson, WI. Members present Bob Baumann, Bruce Hanson, James Johnson, Sue Kattas, Heather Logelin, and Carrie Whitacre (joined at 6:08 p.m.). Administrators in attendance included Superintendent Nick Ouellette, Assistant Superintendent Dave Grambow, Chief Financial, and Operations Officer Tim Erickson, Chief of Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker, Chief of Schools Officer Erin Schiltgen, Director of Teaching and Learning Sandra Kovatch.
- 2. Director of Teaching and Learning Sandra Kovatch congratulated Hudson High School Juniors Amanda Ichel and Alex Weaver for achieving a perfect score on the ACT test. Only one-tenth of one percent of all students taking the ACT test achieve a perfect score of 36.
- 3. Four citizens spoke to the Board of Education regarding the Hudson Middle School pool. Alex and Karrie Weaver and Paul and Laurie Stein.
- 4. Superintendent Ouellette provided an update on the District Scorecards. With five areas of measurement, 1-Strong academic achievement, 2-Prepare students for post-graduate success with life skills, 3-Supportive and inclusive learning environment, 4-Recruiting, retaining and supporting quality employees, and 5-Parents and community are engaged and know what's going on. Building level scorecards will be developed and shared at a future Board meeting.
- 5. Superintendent Ouellette outlined a plan to make up the instructional days missed due to inclement weather. The Board will take action on a recommended plan later in the meeting.
- 6. Chief of Schools Officer Erin Schiltgen introduced Anna Johnson, founder of The Butterfly Path, a locally based organization raising funds to support mental health education. The Butterfly Path donation will support co-located mental health programs in the District.
- 7. Sandra Kovatch introduced Middle School Instructional Coach MaryBeth Elliott, who reviewed the English Language Arts curriculum in grades 6-8.
- 8. Chief of Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker introduced Steve Schoenecker the Assistant Director of Transportation. Schoenecker demonstrated the new tablet technology that will be on buses, allowing students and drivers to monitor who is riding each bus. He also discussed the Traversa software that will allow the District to know the location of each bus during their routes.

- 9. Chief Financial and Operations Officer Tim Erickson reviewed the second Friday of January enrollment numbers, as reported to the Department of Public Instruction. The Hudson School District was up six students for a total of 5,682 students in grades 4K through 12.
- 10. Assistant Superintendent Dave Grambow, Chief of Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker, and Chief of Schools Officer Erin Schiltgen reviewed plans related to transitioning students to new elementary schools due to the elementary boundary changes. Multiple events and forms of communication will allow students opportunities to learn about their new schools.
- 11. Hanson moved, with second by Baumann, to approve the consent items which include approval of the January 14, 2019, regular Board meeting minutes, the January 28, 2019, special Board meeting minutes, the personnel hires, changes, retirements, resignations, non-renewals, terminations, and leaves (attached), Expenditures in the amount of \$2,160,542.98, Receipts totaling \$9,255,084.77, Payroll totaling \$2,209,991.33 and EFT/ACH payments totaling \$1,416,233.34. The motion carried.
- 12. Chief of Human Resources Officer Andrea Voelker recognized the retirement of High School Associate Principal Wendy Langer and teachers David Hammond, Therese Swinney, Kathy Heth, Patricia Steely, Jonathan Hilding, and Susan Randall. All retirees will be recognized at the staff recognition banquet on Monday, April 29th.
- 13. Kattas moved, with second by Hanson, to deny the Van Nurden petition to transfer property from the Hudson School District to the River Falls School District. The motion carried.
 - 14. Hanson moved, with second by Logelin to approve the inclement weather make-up plan. The motion carried.
 - 15.At 7:55 p.m. Hanson moved, with second by Kattas to convene to closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(f) to consider social or personal histories of such persons which if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data. 



The law provides that a majority of the electors residing in the territory, or the owners of 50% or more of the territory, may appeal the denial to an appeal panel by filing notice of appeal with the secretary of the School District Boundary Appeal Board <u>before</u> the March 15 following the denial. See s.115.01 (13), Wisconsin statutes, for a definition of electors.



SUBCHAPTER II STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

115.28 General duties. The state superintendent shall:

- (1) GENERAL SUPERVISION. Ascertain the condition of the public schools, stimulate interest in education and spread as widely as possible a knowledge of the means and methods which may be employed to improve the schools.
- (2) SECTARIANISM. Exclude all sectarian books and instruction from the public schools.
- (3) SUPERVISION OF SCHOOLS. Supervise and inspect the public schools and day schools for children with disabilities, advise the principals and local authorities thereof and give assistance in organizing such schools.
- (3m) SUPERVISION OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCIES; RULES. (a) Supervise and audit the receipts and expenditures of the cooperative educational service agencies, conduct program review of the agencies, supervise boundary reorganization where necessary, advise the administrators of the agencies and provide assistance in organizing the agencies throughout the state.
- (b) Promulgate rules establishing procedures for the reorganization of cooperative educational service agencies and boundary appeals.
- (4) PUBLIC INFORMATION. By reports, bulletins, circulars, correspondence and public addresses, give the public information upon the different methods of school organization and management and the subject of education generally.
- (5) APPEALS. Examine and determine all appeals which by law are made to the state superintendent and prescribe rules of practice in respect thereto, not inconsistent with law.
- (6) ANNUAL CONVENTIONS. Annually, hold conventions of school district administrators, supervisors and agency coordinators.

- 117.15 Criteria for school district reorganizations. In making any decision under ss. 117.08 to 117.132, a school board, the board and an appeal panel shall consider the following factors as they affect the educational welfare of all of the children residing in all of the affected school districts, and may consider other appropriate factors:
- (1) The geographical and topographical characteristics of the affected school districts, including the estimated travel time to and from school for pupils in the school districts.
- (2) The educational needs of all of the children residing in the affected school districts, the educational programs currently offered by each affected school district and the ability and commitment of each school district to meet those needs and continue to offer those educational programs.
- (2m) If territory is proposed to be detached from one school district and attached to an adjoining school district or proposed to be included in a new school district under s. 117.105, whether the proposed detachment will have any adverse effect on the program currently offered by the school district from which the territory is proposed to be detached, including both curricular and extracurricular aspects of that program.
- (3) The testimony of and written statements filed by the residents of the affected school districts.
- (4) The estimated fiscal effect of the proposed reorganization on the affected school districts, including the effect of the apportionment of assets and liabilities.
- (5) Whether the proposed reorganization will make any part of a school district's territory noncontiguous.
- (6) The socioeconomic level and racial composition of the pupils who reside or will reside in territory proposed to be detached from one school district and attached to an adjoining school district, in territory proposed to be included in a new school district under s. 117.105 or in school districts proposed to be consolidated or in a school district proposed to be dissolved; the proportion of the pupils who reside in such territory who are children at risk, as defined under s. 118.153(1)(a); and the effect that the pupils described in this paragraph will have on the present and future socioeconomic level and racial composition of the affected school districts and on the proportion of the affected school districts' enrollments that will be children at risk.
 - (7) The results of any referendum held under s. 117.10.
