Early Childhood Indicators Back-to-School Checklist

Indicator 6: Preschool Educational Environments

Percent of children with IEPs aged 3, 4, and aged 5 who are not enrolled in kindergarten:

- A. Attending a regular early childhood program and receiving the majority of special education and related services in the regular early childhood program.
- B. Attending separate special education class, separate school or residential facility.
- C. Receiving special education and related services in the home.

To Check

- ✓ Review with staff the preschool educational environment reporting categories and codes.
- ✓ Have new staff listen to the <u>Indicator 6 Accurate Coding Webinar</u>.
- Review current educational environment codes within the district's Student Information System (SIS) for ALL children aged 3, 4, and aged 5 who are not enrolled in kindergarten prior to the October 1 Child Count to ensure accurate reporting.

Indicator 7: Child Outcomes

Percent of preschool children with IEPs who demonstrate improved:

- A. Positive social-emotional skills (including social relationships),
- B. Acquisition and use of knowledge and skills (including early language/communication and early
- C. literacy), and
- D. Use of appropriate behaviors to meet their needs.

To Check

- ✓ Ensure a Special Education Portal Early Childhood Administrator is designated. This is the person(s) in the LEA responsible for managing access to the Indicator 7 Child Outcomes application.
- ✓ Identify staff responsible for determining child outcomes ratings and reporting.
- ✓ Grant access to the Indicator 7 Child Outcomes application using WISEsecure to new staff. Have new staff listen to the Indicator 7 Child Outcomes: <u>Back to the Basics webinar</u>.
- ✓ Terminate access to the Indicator 7 Child Outcomes application using WISEsecure for staff no longer employed by the LEA or whose job responsibilities within the LEA have changed.
- ✓ Review with staff the child outcomes rating process and reporting requirements.

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Indicator 12: Preschool Transition

Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3, who are found eligible for Part B, and who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthdays.

To Check

- ✓ Ensure a Special Education Portal Preschool Administrator has been designated. This is the person(s) in the LEA responsible for managing access to the Indicator 12 Preschool Transition application.
- ✓ Identify staff responsible for accessing and processing referrals received from the Birth to 3 Program.
- ✓ Identify staff responsible for completing the Indicator 12 reporting for each referral received.
- ✓ Grant access to the Preschool Transition Application using WISEsecure to new staff.
- ✓ Terminate access to the Preschool Transition Application using WISEsecure for staff no longer employed by the LEA or whose job responsibilities within the LEA have changed.
- Review and update staff to receive the Birth to 3 Program notification and referral email alerts using the LEA Contact tab within the Preschool Transition Application.
- ✓ Review with staff internal procedures for processing referrals and Indicator 12 reporting requirements.
