| When you are at school, how often do you feel safe from physical harm? | Percent responding “never” or “rarely.” | 29.53 |
| During the past 12 months, have you ever been bullied on school property? | Percent responding “yes.” | 12.38 |
| Do you agree or disagree that harassment and bullying by other students is a problem at your school? | Percent responding “agree” or “strongly agree.” | 41.68 |
| During the past 12 months, how many times have you attended school under the influence of alcohol or other illegal drugs, such as marijuana or cocaine? | Percent responding one or more times. | 16.06 |
| During the past 12 months, has anyone offered, sold, or given you an illegal drug on school property? | Percent responding “yes.” | 24.11 |
| Do you agree or disagree that your teachers really care about you and give you a lot of encouragement? | Percent responding “disagree” or “strongly disagree.” | 23.26 |
| Is there at least one teacher or other adult in this school that you can talk to if you have a problem? | Percent responding “no.” | 17.61 |
| Do you agree or disagree that you feel like you belong at this school? | Percent responding “disagree” or “strongly disagree.” | 12.50 |
