Department will hold public hearing on emergency rule related to age waivers for GED tests

MADISON —The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction will hold an administrative rules hearing to accept public testimony on a proposed emergency rule related to age waivers for general educational development tests.

The proposed rule seeks to amend Wis. Admin. Code sec PI 5 to clarify the means in which the minimum age requirement may be waived for persons seeking a certificate of educational development by passing the general educational development (GED) test.

The DPI will hold the public hearing by teleconference only. Additional information on attending is provided below. Written comments received no later than the date of the hearing will be given the same consideration as testimony presented at the hearing.
