Department will hold public hearing on proposed rule related to age waivers for GED tests

MADISON — The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction will hold an administrative rules hearing to accept public testimony on a proposed permanent rule <u>related to age waivers for general educational</u> development tests.

The proposed rule seeks to amend <u>Wis. Admin. Code sec PI 5</u> to clarify the means in which certain students who are at least 17 years of age and are seeking a certificate of educational development may completed the general educational development (GED) test. The proposed rule would repeal the current rule requirement, which provides that eligible students who are at least 17 years of age must wait to take the final GED test until the end of the semester in which the student turns 18, thereby allowing students to take the test when they are ready to do so.

The DPI will hold the public hearing by teleconference only. Additional information on attending is provided below. Written comments received no later than the date of the hearing will be given the same consideration as testimony presented at the hearing.
